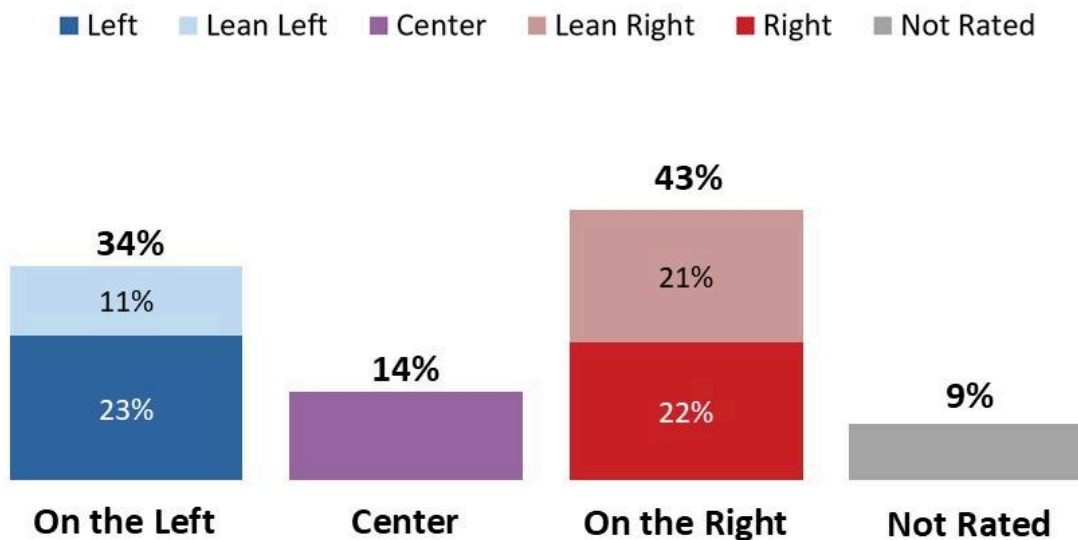

Overview

An AllSides analysis of [RealClearPolitics](#) (RCP) in July 2025 found that it displayed more sources with an AllSides Media Bias Rating™ on the right than the left or center.

Overall, **34% were from outlets on the left (23% Left, 11% Lean Left), 14% from Center-rated outlets, and 43% from outlets on the right (22% Right, 21% Lean Right).** [New York Post Opinion \(Right bias\)](#) and [MSNBC \(Left\)](#) were the two most commonly featured source on RealClearPolitics.

Based on the analysis AllSides rated RealClearPolitics Center (0.18).

The results of the July 2025 AllSides RealClearPolitics Analysis were fairly consistent with AllSides' [2023 analysis](#) of RealClearPolitics. While its curation both of sources on the left and right increased, its curation of sources on the right increased more, leading to sources on the right appearing 9% more than those on the left.

The July 2025 AllSides RealClearPolitics, conducted from July 14 – July 27, cross-referenced articles curated on [realclearpolitics.com](#) with the AllSides Media Bias Rating™ for each source. [AllSides Media Bias Ratings™](#) are determined by a methodology that reflects the average

judgment of all Americans. This report provides details about the methodology and how the analysis avoided bias on the part of the researchers.

Note that this analysis does not investigate whether the political leanings or biases displayed by RealClearPolitics is intentional. Whether RealClearPolitics should provide a broader or more balanced diversity of perspectives, and whether that would support or hinder a healthier democratic society, is a philosophical or ethical question beyond the bounds of this analysis.

Purpose & Methodology

AllSides conducted this media bias analysis of RealClearPolitics to determine the political bias of the aggregator based on the media outlets it curates.

Content Collection & Analysis

AllSides collected the top stories displayed on RealClearPolitics' homepage over the course of a two-week period from July 14 – 27, 2025, at 9:00am ET each day. This consisted of pulling from the top 10 articles from the RCP's Morning Edition and Afternoon Edition each day, with the exception of Saturdays, in which the aggregator only had a Morning Edition. Some days, less than 10 articles were in an Edition, resulting in only that number of articles being pulled for analysis.

In addition to top stories, RealClearPolitics has an Editorials section on its homepage, which features four editorials per day; AllSides collected these as well.

How AllSides Made This Analysis as Objective as Possible

In an effort to be as objective as possible in the analysis, **AllSides only took the bias of the media outlet into account — not the content of the article itself.** For example, any article curated from The New York Post was considered Lean Right, reflecting the outlet's overall AllSides Media Bias Rating at the time of the analysis. AllSides Media Bias Ratings reflect the average view of people across the political spectrum, not one individual or group. AllSides' media bias rating methodology is based on Blind Bias Surveys of Americans across the political spectrum and expert panel reviews by a multipartisan group, preventing one elite group or individual from having a disproportionate impact on the ratings.

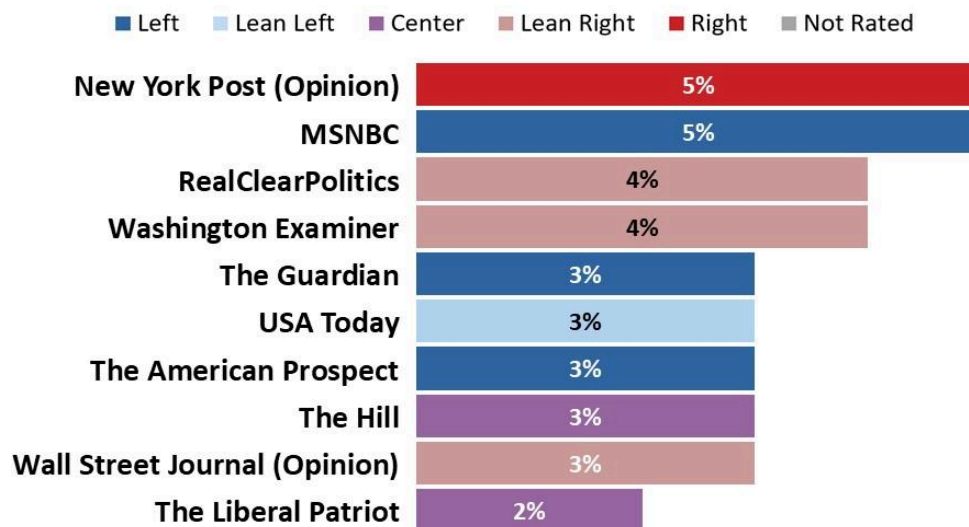
In-Depth Findings

The AllSides analysis found that RealClearPolitics aggregated articles from news outlets across the political spectrum in the top content found on its homepage, often in a balanced manner. However, its Editorials section featured articles more often associated with outlets rated by AllSides as Right or Lean Right.

Top Outlets Curated

Of the 315 total articles analyzed, the top five sources appearing the most often were [New York Post Opinion \(Right bias\)](#), [MSNBC \(Left bias\)](#), [RealClearPolitics' original content \(Lean Right bias\)](#), [Washington Examiner \(Lean Right bias\)](#), and [The Guardian \(Left bias\)](#).

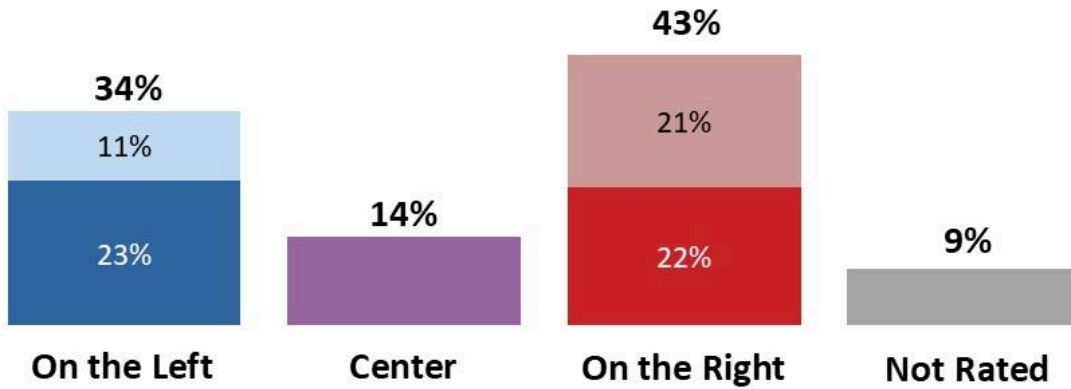


Bias of Outlets Curated

Of all 315 articles analyzed (including Morning Editions, Afternoon Editions, and Editorials section), 34% were from outlets on the left (23% Left, 11% Lean Left), 14% from Center-rated outlets, and 43% from outlets on the right (22% Right, 21% Lean Right). Nine percent of articles were from outlets not rated by AllSides.

■ Left ■ Lean Left ■ Center ■ Lean Right ■ Right ■ Not Rated

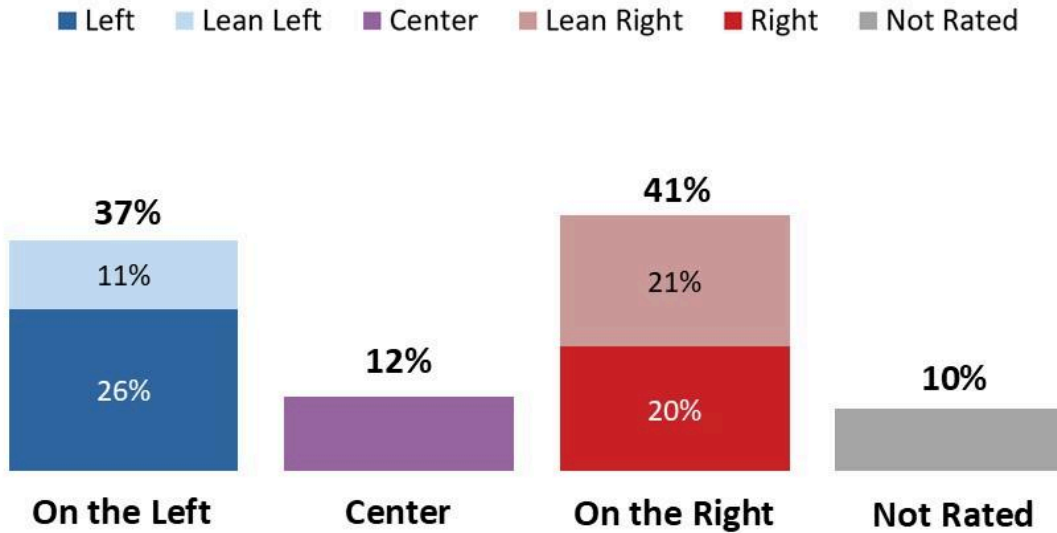

Of just RealClearPolitics' Morning and Afternoon Editions, of which 259 articles were evaluated, 37% were from outlets on the left (26% Left, 11% Lean Left), 12% from Center-rated outlets, and 41% from outlets on the right (20% Right, 21% Lean Right). Ten percent of articles were from outlets not rated by AllSides.

AllSides Media Bias Ratings™ of Sources Featured on RealClearPolitics' Morning/Afternoon Editions

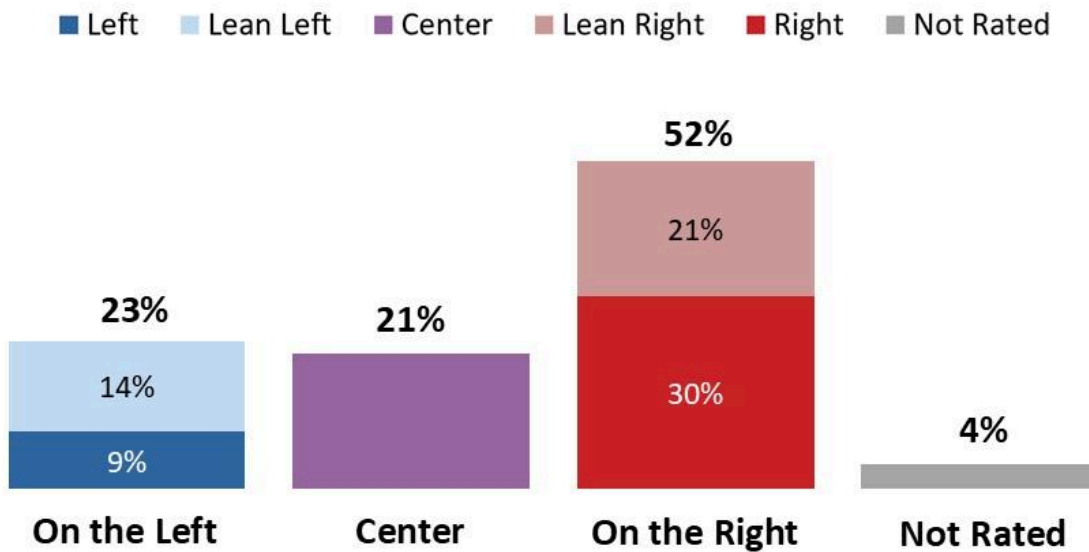

Of just RealClearPolitics' Editorial section, of which 56 articles were evaluated, 23% were from outlets on the left (9% Left, 14% Lean Left), 21% from Center-rated outlets, and 52% from outlets on the right (30% Right, 21% Lean Right). Four percent of articles were from outlets not rated by AllSides.

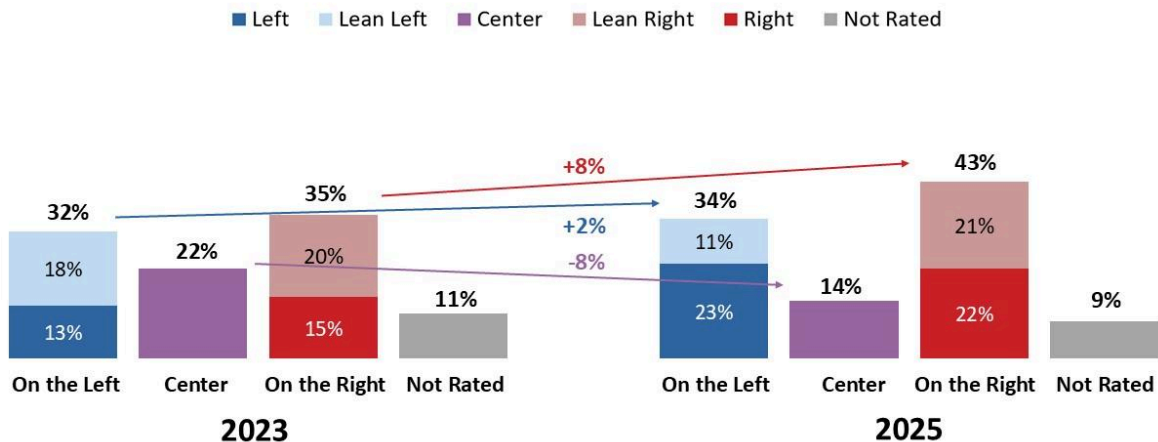
Notably, RealClearPolitics' Editorials section curated more from outlets rated by AllSides as on the right, compared to aggregated content found in its Morning and Afternoon Editions.

2023 and 2025 Data Compared

AllSides conducted an [analysis of RealClearPolitics in 2023](#), collecting 622 articles over a 14-day period.

The 2023 analysis found 32% of sources had a Left or Lean Left AllSides Media Bias Rating, 22% had a Center Media Bias Rating, and 35% had a Right or Lean Right rating. The top outlets curated across RealClearPolitics were [Washington Examiner](#), [RealClearPolitics](#) original content, [New York Post](#), [The Hill](#), [CNN](#), [Fox News](#), [The Atlantic](#), [Financial Times](#), [The Guardian](#), and [The Federalist](#).

In the 2025 analysis, RealClearPolitics increased its curation from right by 8% and increased its curation from the left by 2%, while it decreased curation from Center-rated sources by 8%. While some of the top sources remained the same, others changed. CNN, Fox News, The Atlantic, Financial Times, and The Federalist were no longer in the top ten sources while MSNBC, USA Today, American Prospect, Wall Street Journal Opinion, and The Liberal Patriot were added to the top ten.

Overall, RealClearPolitics' bias remained relatively consistent over the two-year period, however, the gap between sources on the left and right was 3% in 2023 and it grew to 9% in 2025.

Rating Changes Over Time

Note that while the 2023 and 2025 analyses used the same methodologies, AllSides Media Bias Ratings change over time, which affect the comparison. For example, over the two-year period CNN moved from Left to Lean Left, The Guardian moved from Lean Left to Left, and RealClearPolitics original content moved from Center to Lean Right. AllSides has also expanded its ratings, so some sources may have moved from Not Rated to Left, Lean Left, Center, Lean Right, or Right.

Background on RealClearPolitics

[RealClearPolitics](#), which also goes by RCP, is primarily a news aggregator that provides content from various news media outlets. The site also has a dedicated team which writes original content. The news outlet is also known for its curation of [election polls](#).

As of July 2025, RealClearPolitics, as an aggregator, had a Center rating (0.16). Its original content is rated separately. Its rating is based on the 2023 AllSides Analyses and an editorial review conducted in February 2025, which also resulted in the decision to rate its original content separate from the aggregator.

RealClearPolitics' [About page](#) describes itself as “dedicated to providing our readers with better, more insightful analysis of the most important news and policy issues of the day.” It also claims to have a commitment to political balance (emphasis from AllSides):

*“[RealClearPolitics]’ daily editorial curation and original reporting present **balanced, non-partisan analysis** that empowers our readers to stay informed... RCP’s staff of experienced journalists delivers insightful and **impartial news** and analysis from the White House, Congress, the campaign trail, and roundtable discussions on CNN, MSNBC, and Fox News... We also field a roster of contributing columnists **spanning the political spectrum.**”*

RealClearPolitics was [founded](#) in 2000 by Tom Bevan and John McIntyre. They are a part of the RealClear [brand](#) that includes 14 other websites, such as RealClearWorld, RealClearSports, RealClearInvestigations, RealClearDefense. In 2007, Forbes Media [took a 51% equity stake in RealClear Holdings](#). In 2015, Crest Media, which owns the Middle East news outlet Al-Monitor, and the original owners bought out a [large equity stake](#) that had been possessed by Forbes Media. Crest Media was [founded](#) by the president and chairman of Crest Investment Company Jamal Daniel.

- **Blind Bias Surveys** — A survey that asks respondents to rate the media bias of a news outlet on a left-right scale without knowing the news source or author they are reviewing. AllSides normalizes these data based on respondent ideology to ensure that the audience reflects the social and political diversity of the nation.
- **Editorial Reviews** — A multipartisan panel conducts in-depth reviews of a media outlet. The Editorial Review Panel includes people from across the political spectrum. During this process, each reviewer independently evaluates and suggests a rating for the source. Then, the group discusses individual findings, shares impressions, and comes to an agreement on the result.
- **Third Party Data** — When available and relevant, data that is conducted by a transparent, credible source may inform AllSides Media Bias Ratings™. AllSides always notes which third-party analyses it has taken to account on the source page for any outlet.
- **Community Feedback** — Visitors to AllSides.com can vote on the rating for any outlet. This feedback does not determine our ratings, but may trigger a deeper review.
- **Independent Reviews** — An AllSides reviewer assesses content and comes to a general conclusion on a source’s bias. This is AllSides’ lowest level of analysis, usually undertaken to give initial, low-confidence ratings.
